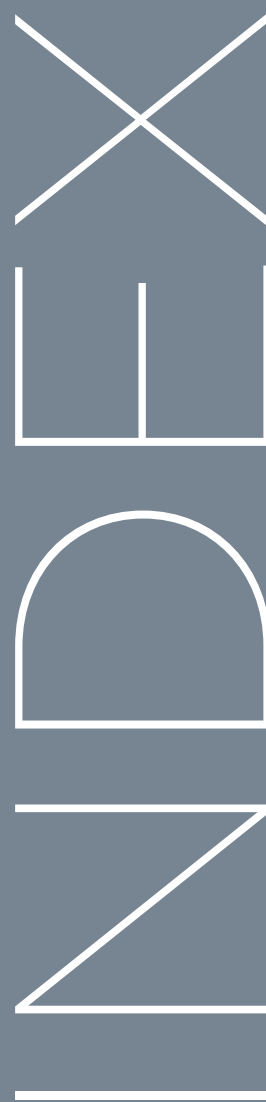

Place objects together on the window sill which at first you may have thought did not particularly go well together. You can create a new and more personal style if you mix materials of different structures and appearances.

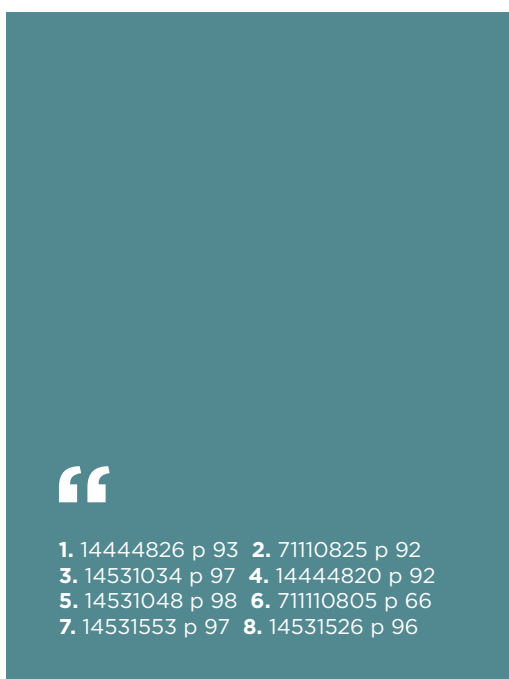
